

Zines have a long **history of activism**. They have been used by **marginalised people** to **share ideas** that may not necessarily be represented in popular media.


If we think about the characters in Ward 76, their experiences aren't always widely understood. There can be a lot of stigma around illness.



Imagine you were spreading awareness about teenagers experience of illness and hospital. What messages would you use to help people understand?




